competition, as well as entries carved from rough outs and instructor assisted projects. The carving categories will be similar to the 2015 show.

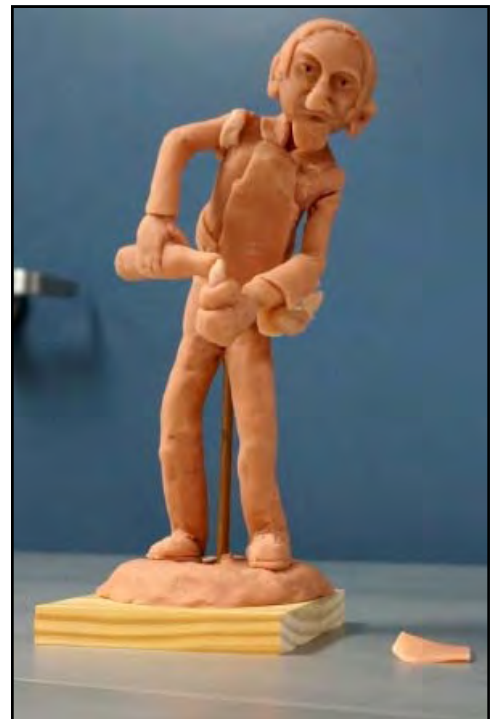
Dallas Deege plans to be there to sell his carving tools and supplies.

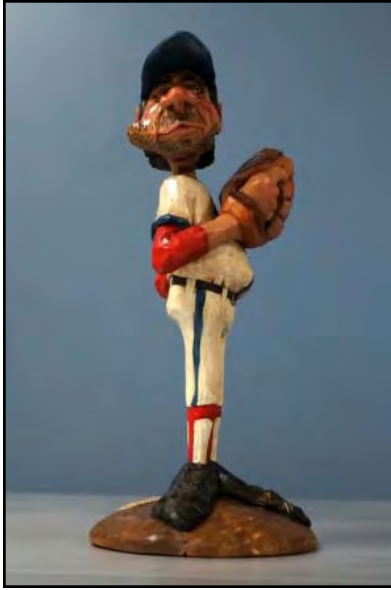
