Harry Seurkamp Class November 19, 2016

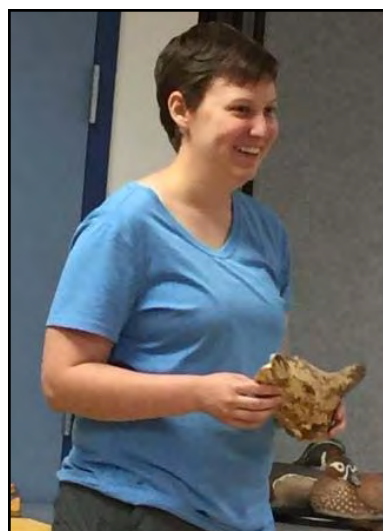

room next to us. The class is \$55 including the blank and written instructions. Beginner carvers are welcome. Harry can take up to 20 people.

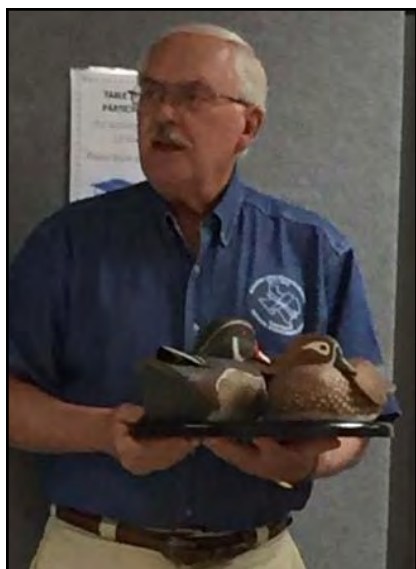
Those who wish to take the class must sign up and make a commitment. The class previously scheduled for November has been moved to January.
