This will help vol-

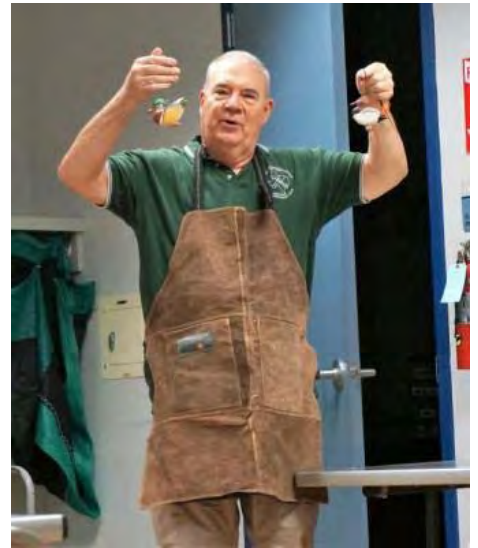
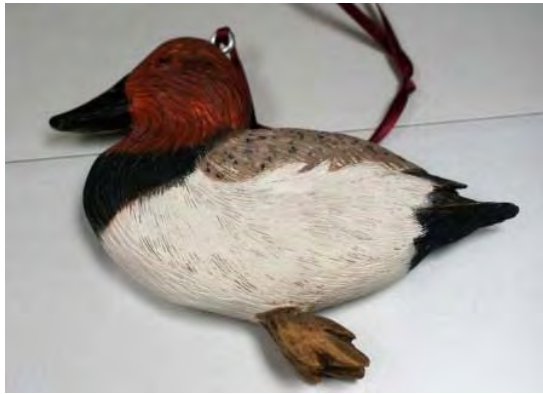
unteers make key
