that elusive moniker of a "Great Carving"?

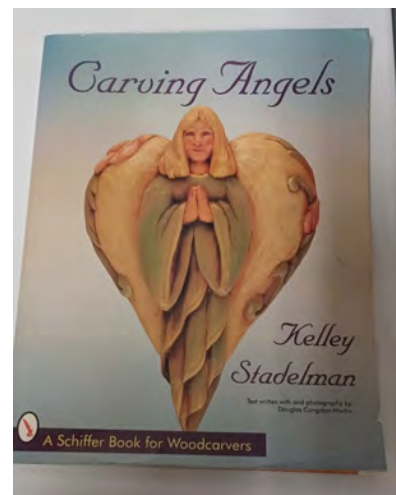
I've seen working on display, that although carved well, the subject matter turns me off. Would I consider it a great carving just because it's on display?
