**Orlando Villarreal** — Power Carving: Marlin Bust, Eagle Head Bust or Elk bust

**3-Day Class:**

**Class Cost:** \$150 plus \$45 for blank

**Participants:** Minimum of 8-12

**Skill Level:** Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced.

**Tools Required:** Dust collector, Dremel® or Foredom® power carving burrs and small sanders. Knives and hand tools may also be used.

Orlando will offer three different carving subjects for the class, including a Marlin bust, an Eagle head bust and an Elk bust. He also will teach a cold cast bronze finish. The Eagle head will be finished natural. As a power carving class, a dust collector will be required. Tools are a high-speed grinder such as a Dremel or Foredom, power carving burrs and small sanders. Knives and hand tools can be used.

Orlando is a national award-winning artist, specializing in aquatic and wildlife wood sculpture.

**Class Cost:** \$30 per day plus \$35 for blank

**Participants:** Minimum of 6 - 10

**Skill Level:** Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced.

**Tools Required:** Hand carving or power carving tools. Dust collector if using power tools. Paint Brushes

The class project is an Orca Whale. Wanda says the carving can be done in three days, including painting. The carving can be done with power or hand carving tools. If you plan to use power, bring a dust collector. Besides the power or hand carving tools, bring your paint brushes. Also, Wanda says carvers can provide the habitat to use with the whale. However, she will have habitats for sale.

**Dallas Deege** — Caricature Carving

**1-Day Class:** \$50, plus blanks \$5 each

**2-Day Class:** \$100, plus blanks \$5 each

**Participants:** Maximum 12, Minimum 6

**Skill Level:** Intermediate & Advanced

**Tools required:** Glove, Carving Knife, Palm Tools, V Tools, Gouges, etc.

Class is structured for one on one instruction with some group lectures. Emphasis is on teaching caricature carving. The class will include discussions on key points to consider in preparation for caricature techniques and skills on facial expressions. For those interested in competing in whittling contests this class will be a big help. Dallas will talk about some of the secrets to winning a whittling contest. Students will learn how to layout and carve a face out of a block of wood 1 ½" x 1 ½" x 5".
