Class No. 1

Lance Rath — Bear

3-Day Class:

Class Cost: \$60 plus \$5 for blank

Participants: Minimum of 8-12

Skill Level: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced.

Tools Required: Glove, Carving Knife, Palm Tools, V-Gouges, etc.

Lance will offer two different poses of a bear carving project. The student has the choice of one bear pose or both poses. While carving the bear, the class will concentrate on carving techniques.



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Class No. 2

Wanda Reichert — Shallow Relief Carving

3-Day Class:

Class Cost: \$30 per day plus \$10 - \$15 for blanks

Participants: Minimum of 6 - 10

Skill Level: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced.

Tools Required: Glove, Carving Knife, Palm Tools, V Tools, Gouges, etc.

The class project is relief carving. Wanda will have assorted patterns and students may bring a pattern—if it's ok. Painting is included in all classes.



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Class No. 3

Dallas Deege — Caricature Carving

2-Day Class: \$50, plus blanks \$5 each
(Thurs/Fri)

Participants: Maximum 12, Minimum 6

Skill Level: Intermediate & Advanced

Tools required: Glove, Carving Knife, Palm Tools, V Tools, Gouges, etc.

Class is structured for one on one instruction with some group lectures. Emphasis is on teaching caricature techniques. Learn the concepts of how to design, layout and carve a face. For those interested in competing in whittling contests this class will be a big help. Dallas will talk about some of the secrets to winning a whittling contest. Students will learn how to layout and carve a face out of a block of wood 1 ½" x 1 ½" x 5".



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Class No. 4

Carolyn Halbrook — Chip Carving

3-Day Class: \$105 plus \$2 - \$60 for blanks

Participants: Minimum of 8-12

Skill Level: Beginner, Intermediate & Advance

Tools required: Chip Carving Knife. Light would help

Class will involve a choice of chip carving projects suitable for the different skill levels. Class projects range from ornaments, to crosses, to boxes, to round plates. Students will learn how to hold the knife and techniques in basic cuts including rosettes. Also, lettering instruction is available as part of the class. A practice board is included in the base \$105.fee. A project fee, depending on the project, ranges from \$2 to \$60.
